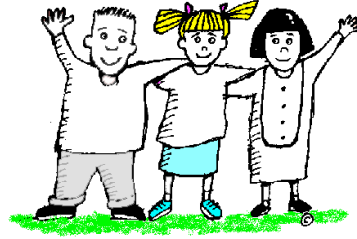


WEB Recipe

W.E.B. – purpose is to entangle children with **W**onderfully **E**xciting **B**ooks.

- Start with a theme or central subject.
- Divide your topic into at least 4 subtopics or ‘spokes’.
- Determine a grade level for your web.
- E-mail your topic, subtopics, and grade level to booklady@siu.edu ASAP.
- Identify Illinois State Goals your activities will meet.



After selecting your theme, chose children’s books to fit each subtopic. Books should include fiction, non-fiction, and poetry, as well as read-aloud-titles, individual reading titles and group discussion titles.

After selecting the children’s literature for each spoke, you must find an activity to use with each book. Activities should extend the book and develop a deeper understanding of the topic. Activities should represent different aspects of the curriculum: music, art, math, language arts, reading, social studies, science, etc. Each activity must have a goal (State Standard) and an assessment that matches the goal.

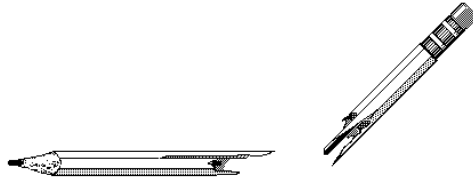
Chose quality books as the core of the literature web.
